BELAJAR DI BAHASA INDONESIA LEARNING In INDONESIAN

Let me introduce **Kursi Luar Biasa (KLB)** The Amazing Chair!

Students who sit in **KLB** are asked lots of questions in Indonesian about themselves (name, age, pets, etc). **KLB** involves student voice by asking students personal questions, it provides students with a platform to talk about themselves. For the older students we allow them to respond either truthfully or not! This allows us to be creative and have some fun.



Question words that we have used include **Siapa?** Who? **Apa?** What? **Berapa?** How many? **Mana?** Where?

At the moment we are using both Indonesian and English to ask and respond to questions. With more practice we will begin using more and more Indonesian. So far we have been amazed by our comprehension and understanding what is being said in Indonesian.

This activity is a great way to practise everyday conversation, learn about how to ask and respond to questions and also get to know more about each other!
