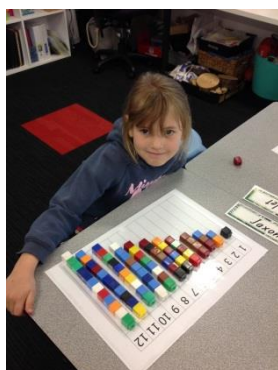
2018 AQUATICS WEEK
