
HELLO FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM

<b>2019 Materials and Services Charges</b> The Governing Council Finance Committee has made its recommendation for 2019 Materials and Services charges. It is recommending the charge of \$241.00 which covers all educational materials for the year. This amount is the standard sum set for 2019 in line with Section 106A of the Education Act.
This equates to a materials and services fee of \$1.42 per day for your child. The Excursion/Incursion levy, used for out of school excursions and visiting performers will be \$44 in 2019, this cost is in addition to the materials and services charges making total fees \$285 for 2019.
You are invited to attend the Governing Council meeting on Wednesday 31st October, 2018 at 6:30pm where the recommendation will be discussed and considered.
